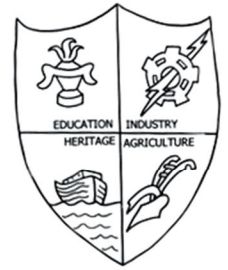

Spencerville Schools is working diligently to resume transportation for all in-district students. Thank you for your patience and support during this process. The bus driver shortage has been a challenge, but we are committed to providing safe and efficient transportation daily. The alternate bus route has been updated for all students under a 1-mile distance from the school. We are asking parents to call the bus driver listed below or Transportation Department by **Sunday, August 28th** at noon to schedule your child(ren) for bus transportation.

The UPDATED transportation plans include 9 in-town stops AND regular transportation for all out of village limits (but under 1 mile), which are:

**9 IN-TOWN STOPS (map included):**

1. Oak St./Brett St. (regular stop)
2. Oak St./4<sup>th</sup> St. (regular stop)

9. Last house on West Elm St. - call Lori Morrison at 419-234-5942

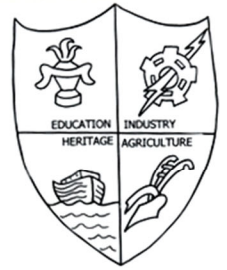
**OUT OF VILLAGE LIMITS (but under 1 mile from the school):**

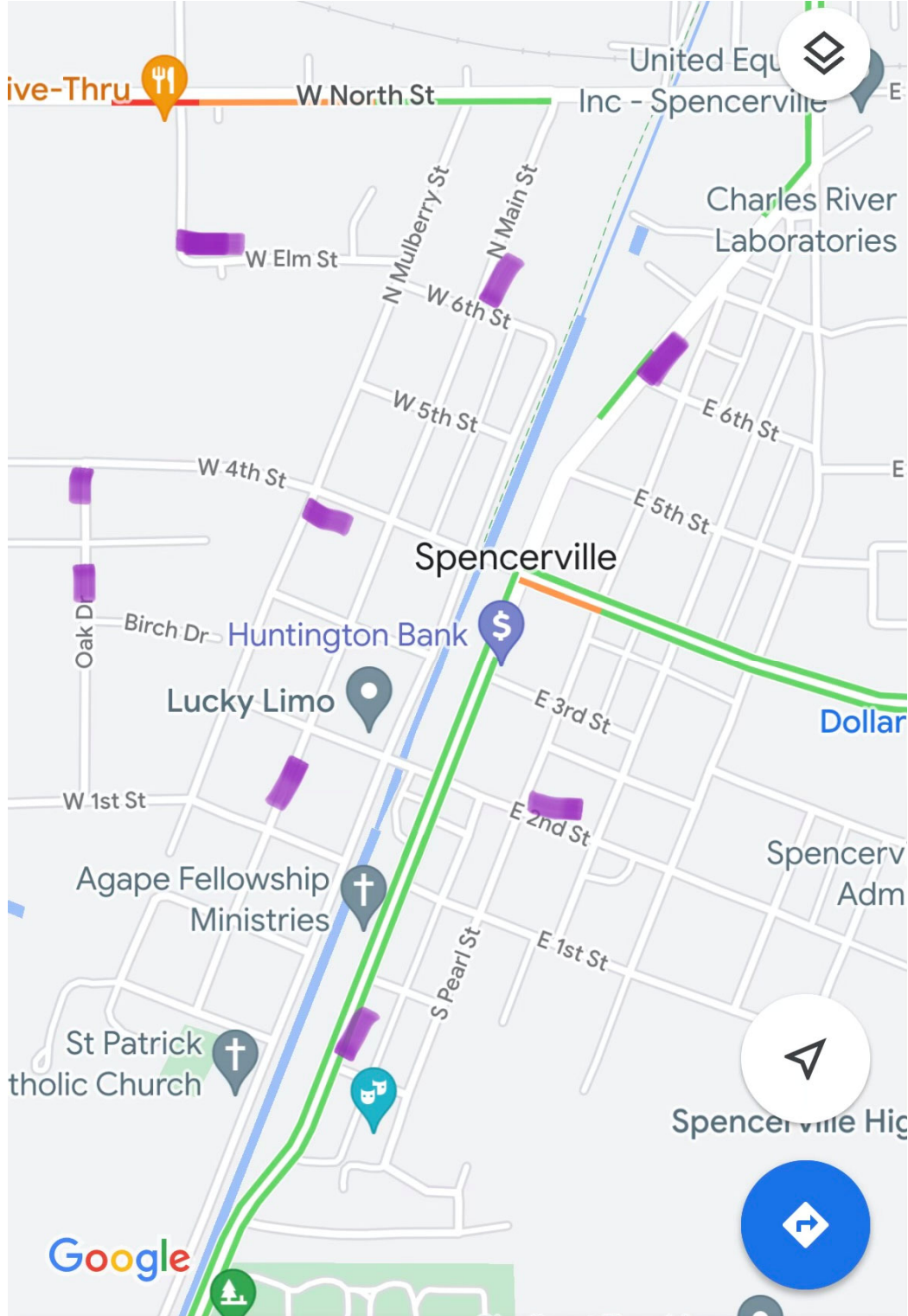
