Open Enrollment Procedures

1. Applications for open enrollment should be completed and returned to the Superintendent's office:

Applications will be dated upon receipt and receipt date may be used as a selection criteria should applicants exceed available space.

2. Open enrollment transfer may not be permitted if enrollment of the grade level or class exceeds space or staff limitations. Individual high school class enrollment is set depending upon sections offered and specific course content and requirements.
3. Annually, applicants will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis with an assurance that resident Spencerville students will not be displaced and open enrolled students from the previous year may be given preference. Enrollment levels will determine annual approval (i.e., approval one year does not guarantee approval in the future). Applications must be submitted annually for all open enrollment requests.
4. No student, once accepted, will be displaced during the school year should enrollment exceed the limits stated above.
5. Students with handicapping conditions may be rejected for open enrollment if the services described in the student's IEP are not available at Spencerville Local Schools. Enrollment limits per special education units shall not be exceeded.
6. OHSAA and Spencerville Local Schools athletic eligibility guidelines will be in effect. Parents should familiarize themselves with these guidelines.
7. Students with discipline/attendance problems will be rejected for open enrollment if they have been suspended or expelled by the sending district.
8. Open enrollment students may be rejected for the following school year if their behavior/attendance is determined to be unsatisfactory by the Superintendent.
9. The Superintendent may reject open enrollment students who have displayed insufficient academic progress.
10. Spencerville Local Schools will accept no responsibility for transportation outside of current district boundaries.
11. The Superintendent has final decision making authority for all situations and conditions not specifically covered in these procedures.
