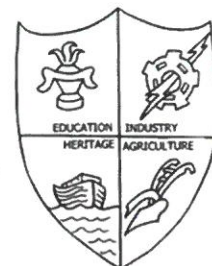

Dear Parents and Students,

I'd like to take this moment to address some important contributions to the success of this school year. Our staff have been consistent with our approach to safely educate and support the youth of Spencerville Local Schools. We plan to continue our "return to school" with a strong emphasis on "staying in school". We are committed to only changing to a full remote plan IF that becomes the last resort, such as not having enough staff or a forced shutdown.

Our students have been cooperative and adaptable to making all the necessary changes along the way. They quickly picked-up on learning new technology and safety protocols. Keeping-up with virtual lessons can be challenging, but we have made great progress due to the resources, training and communication that we have implemented since August.

Our "Remote Monday" plan has served us well in many circumstances, such as with reducing contact tracing, enhanced remote learning practices for students, staff and parents, simultaneously serving our students who are in person, full remote and partial (due to quarantines) remote, and for more in-depth cleaning of facilities and buses.

We will continue to monitor student attendance, grades, and their overall well-being. We will return in person on December 1st where we will take a few weeks to evaluate and decide on our plans for the third quarter.
