

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We were informed on September 10, 2020 that the *National School Lunch Program* (free breakfast and lunch) has been expanded to ALL students in grades K-12, regardless of qualifying for free/reduced status. We quickly applied and on September 11th received notification that we are able to begin this program on Tuesday, September 15th. This program will run through December 31st, 2020 or until funds run out.

In order to receive a free breakfast and/or lunch, both meals must be a <u>complete</u> meal. Students may still purchase extra items at the established prices. Extra milk can be purchased for \$.50. Charges for these items will be taken from the student's current account balance. Any account with a current balance will be held for future meal purchases after the program expires.

It is important for families to continue to complete and return the free/reduced meal application. By completing the application, this ensures the potential approval for meal benefits once the current program funds are depleted. All full-time Remote Learners may also participate in this program, but will need to contact the school as soon as possible to allow enough time to order food and schedule Monday deliveries. This will begin Sept. 21st for anyone who signs-up after Sept. 11th.
